The following is a summary of charges for attending St Thomas the Apostle for the 2020-2021 school year. This is a nonprofit organization and the total charges represent a partial cost to educate a child at our school. Please honor your commitment promptly.

APPLICATION FEE/TESTING FEE

A nonrefundable \$95.00 application/testing fee per child is due at the time of application to the school.

GENERAL FEE

A nonrefundable \$695.00 general fee per child is due after acceptance into St. Thomas the Apostle School. The general fee includes the following expenses:

KINDERGARTEN, FIRST, AND SECOND GRADE FEES

An additional \$100.00 per month per child for ten months is paid in addition to the tuition for all kindergarten, first, and second grade students. This fee helps cover the costs for the teacher assistant in each grade.

BUILDING FUND

The St. Thomas the Apostle Building Fund of \$275.00 per family is a tax-deductible contribution, which is deposited into a building fund account and will be used for capital improvements and building repairs. This fee is nonrefundable.

AFTERSCHOOL STARZ CLUB PROGRAM FEE (formerly known as Extended Care)

Children who enroll in this program shall pay a registration fee of \$26.00 per child. The cost is \$144.00-\$349.00 a month depending on the number of days attended per week. The program begins after school and ends at 6:00 p.m.

SPANISH FEE

Spanish fee is \$80.00 per student.

PTG DUES

The \$75.00 fee per family per year enables the Parent Teacher Group (PTG) to provide financial resources for parent activities during the year. This fee is nonrefundable.

FACTS (Fast Automated Cash Transfer System) TUITION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

You may choose quarterly, semiannually or monthly payments over a twelve-month period from July to June to be collected by FACTS. Registration fee of \$50.00 will be charge to you when you register. Registering for FACTS is **MANDATORY**.

SERVICE HOURS

Each family contributes 30 hours per year of service. If you are unable to provide the time, you may pay \$15.00 per hour. Single parents are asked to contribute 15 hours per year.

LATE CHARGE

A late charge of \$25.00 per check will be assessed if any payment is not received within 5 days from a payment due date.

DISHONORED PAYMENT

A bounced check fee of \$25.00 per check will be assessed for any checks returned by the bank. Returned checks will not be redeposited. After two returned checks, families must pay by cashier’s check, money order, or cash.

SPORTS FEES

Students in grades 3 through 8 who choose to join an after school CYO Sports Program by the Sports Committee will be charged a participation fee for each sport.

MISCELLANEOUS FEES

Parents will be asked to pay for activities such as the Eighth Grade Retreat, Graduation, and some special study trips. These expenses are determined yearly.

FUND RAISING PROGRAMS

Tuition and fees DO NOT fully cover the cost to educate your child. Fund raising activities are very important part of school life. Every family is expected to fully participate in the fund raising activities such as *World’s Finest Chocolate Sale* and *Spring Gala Dinner/Auction Sale*. The Sports Committee sponsors fund raising events as well.
